Western Fair Grounds

Hwy #401 to London exit "Highbury Rd." Go North to Florence Rd and turn left. Go to Egerton Rd and turn left. Stables are directly on the right as soon as you turn the corner. The stable entrance/parking is right behind the stabling. Truck and trailer parking is located right at the stable area. (see attached PDF file of Western fair ground map) Competition is directly across the road in front of the grandstand. The grandstand area and the stabling are joined together by an underground tunnel. The International Youth Quarter Horse Show is located along the barn area in the Agriplex.
